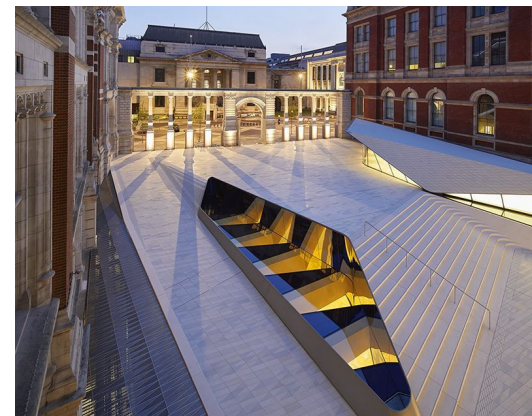
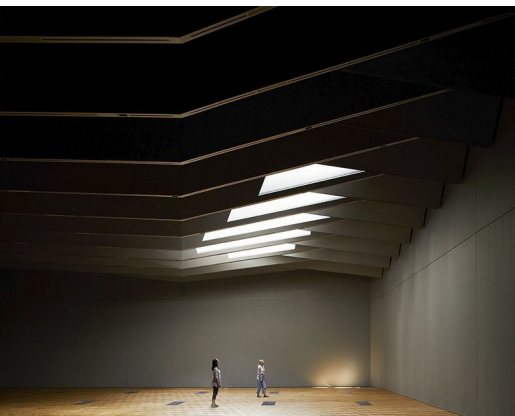

The Victoria and Albert Museum (V&A) is the largest and most famous museum for Design & Craftsmanship. The project consists of a new main entrance, courtyard, cafe and gift shop, and a large pillarless exhibition space 15 meters below ground level. The project was designed by renowned architecture firm AL_A (Amanda Levete Architects). Octatube was involved as glass specialist, the project was finalized in 2017.

Octatube was responsible for the design, engineering, production and assembling of several structural glazed and stainless steel structures. In total there are six components; the Oculus skylight; the triangular skylight above the staircase to the museum hall; the fully glazed cafe and shop facades; the skylight over the gift shop; and the glazed 'link' between the existing Western Range and the new shopping area.
